


The latest commercial real estate market data, provided by Transwestern|RBJ, highlights Framingham's continued strength in the Metrowest region. Through the end of the 3rd quarter of 2016, overall Framingham's office vacancy rates - at 11 percent - continue to remain significantly lower than the 20.1 percent posted by the larger 495 West region.

Tighter vacancy rates are reflected in higher asking rents. In Framingham, 3rd quarter asking rents averaged \$25.33, significantly higher than the \$19.12 average for the 495 West region.



This data points to the ongoing advantage of locating in Framingham, the demographic and economic center of a fast-growing Metrowest region.

That advantage is reflected in rising Framingham commercial property values. Town Assessor data show that between Fiscal Year 2016 and Fiscal Year 2017, Framingham's



commercial market values increased 12 percent. During the same period, industrial property values increased 7 percent.

Commercial property growth was driven by several recent investments and sales, including Lifetime Fitness' newly opened Cochituate Road facility, Yale Lighting's recent Worcester Road purchase, and the sale of 11 Speen Street, a multi-tenant building with excellent MassPike Exit 13 access.

Shortly after opening its [patio space](#) this summer, Jack's Abby Brewing Company recently announced that it will be expanding its space in Downtown Framingham at 100 Clinton Street to an adjacent property at 102 Clinton Street.

The Town's Planning Board approved plans for the restaurant and brewery to lease and develop 102 Clinton Street, a vacant 63,000 square foot building. The company plans to commit much of the space for additional manufacturing and to use as a warehouse. The owners also plan to add a function hall to their existing tasting room while adding tasting space. The restaurant/brewery is also planning to add parking to their current facility, going from 163 parking spaces to 220 spaces. In 2015, the Board of Selectmen and Town Meeting members agreed to a tax-increment financing (TIF) deal with Jack's Abby, where the Town agreed to provide commercial property tax exemptions over 7 years. In return, the company committed to investing \$6 million in improvements, to retaining 19 permanent, full-time jobs and creating 35 permanent full-time jobs, and to maintaining their corporate headquarters at 100 Clinton Street. The company reports its job count is now close to 100. "Jack's Abby is building on their success - and proving the potential of our downtown," said Arthur Robert, Director of Community & Economic Development.

Jack's Abby was founded in 2011 by the Hendlers brothers, and has gained a following among beer aficionados.
